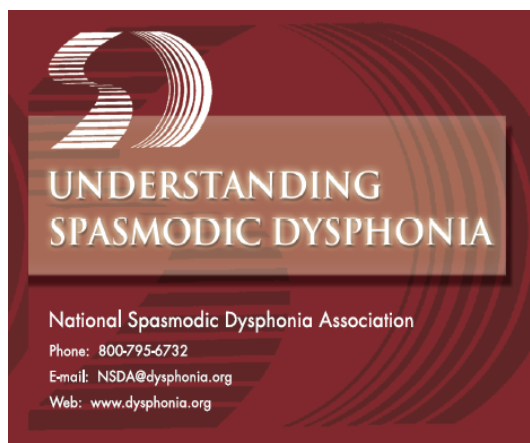

UNDERSTANDING SPASMODIC DYSPHONIA

Spasmodic Dysphonia is an unusual neurological voice disorder that most people have never heard of, yet it affects over 50,000 people in North America and probably many more since it is often undiagnosed or misdiagnosed as chronic laryngitis, allergies, acid reflux or even stress. Living with Spasmodic Dysphonia leaves many people feeling alone and isolated because the ability to communicate is impaired.
